I. PURPOSE

This monetary award is presented to one student technologist and one radiologic technologist who are actively pursuing a career in basic radiology or are enrolled in an advanced radiologic science course.

II. QUALIFICATIONS

- A. If the applicant is a student technologist, they must be a student enrolled in an JRCERT accredited School of Radiologic Sciences in Minnesota for a minimum of six (6) months at the time of application and must still be enrolled at the application deadline, July 15th. The student nominee must be a member of the Minnesota Society of Radiologic Technologists. Proof of maintenance of a "B" or a 3.0 grade point average must be provided.
- B. All applicants must submit the MSRT Scholarship Application form with their essay.
- C. A letter of recommendation from a current MSRT member must accompany each application.
- D. In addition to the above qualifications, the applicant must submit an essay utilizing the following format:
 - 1. Approximately 500 words in length, double spaced, 12 point text format.
 - 2. Do **NOT** include applicant name, program information or any other identifying information in the essay.
 - 3. Address the following question in essay format:
 - a. How do your professional goals align with and support the mission of the MSRT?
 - b. What could you do to improve the profession by establishing and maintaining high education and training standards?
 - c. In what ways could you promote the profession and quality patient care?
 - 4. Applicants must submit their essay to the Awards Chair awards@mnsrt.com.

III. ESSAY JUDGING CRITERIA

- A. Essays will be judged by three (3) impartial judges selected by the current MSRT President. Radiologic science course directors or instructors will not be eligible to serve as judges.
- B. The minimum criteria used for judging shall be:
 - 1. Innovation and thoughtfulness of the applicant's responses
 - 2. The feasibility of ideas presented.
 - 3. The proper use of grammar and spelling.

IV. AWARDING OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

- A. Scholarship recipients will be announced at the MSRT Annual Meeting in the fall of the year.
- B. Presentation of the scholarship(s) will be made at the MSRT Awards Banquet held during the Annual Meeting.
- C. Scholarship recipients will be notified prior to the Annual meeting in order that they may make plans to attend the Awards Banquet and receive their scholarship in person.

V. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- A. Depending on the quantity and type of applications (student technologist or registered technologist), the MSRT reserves the right, if desired, to award both scholarships in the same category if no applications for a specific category are received by the application deadline. For example, if no registered technologist applications are received by the application deadline, the MSRT may award two (2) qualified student technologist scholarships if desired.
- B. At the time of the award the winner will be required to fill out a 1099 per Minnesota Tax Law.
